



A Guide to Reading During Lockdown (Primary 2 - Primary 7)

During lockdown, we will be using Active Learn: Rapid Reading for online reading. This is an online programme that enables pupils to engage with books. At Twechar Primary, we recognise that reading is important in a pupil's development. The books allocated are brief and therefore **pupil's should read one book (a new book) each day.**

This program can be accessed by typing **'ACTIVE LEARN LOG IN'** to any search engine or by clicking on this link:

1. This will take you to the following page where you should click on LOG IN:



 This will then take you to this page where you will require your child's LOG IN details and SCHOOL CODE. These details are contained in the Home Learning packs that can be collected from the school on Monday 11th January:

3. Each pupil will have books pre-set to their account. These books can be accessed through MY STUFF. The number shown corresponds to the number of books the pupil has assigned to their account.



The number on the treasure chest is the number of coins (rewards) a pupil has earned by completing their reading book and answering the questions (see below; point 4). The more coins a pupil earns the more rewards they can unlock. Some of the rewards include unlocking games. These can be accessed through the MY REWARDS tab.

4. Our pupils can read and listen to books and answer the questions. If a pupil is unsure of the word they can click on that word where the program will help your child. To answer questions about the text, you should click on the FACE icon on the page.



To navigate to the next page, you should click on the green arrow.

Using this program, we will be able to support pupils as it will provide us with assessment information. <u>It is essential that our pupils are reading a new book each</u> <u>day.</u>

IMPORTANT: Our pupils have never used this program before so they will require parent support to access this in the first instance.
