Pupil Leadership Groups

Absence and Late coming

Over the last academic year, pupil absence and late coming was at a level that has had an impact on pupil learning. Evidence supports that poor attendance and regular late coming can negatively impact on how well a child does at school.

This session, we will be monitoring attendance and late-coming regularly. Where pupil absence or late coming is high, parents will be informed and the school will work with you to improve this.

If your child is going to be absent from school the office should be notified by 9.15am at the latest. The office will follow East Dunbartonshire Council policy where no contact has been made with the school.

Parent Portal

You have now received information about the new Parent Portal for East Dunbartonshire schools. This portal is designed to enable you to perform functions such as registering absence of children, returning forms such as data forms, paying school meals and even registering for the 'free bus travel for children' scheme.

PE Days

You have now received the letter regarding our PE days for each class. May I remind you that children should continue to wear school uniform during their PE days. However, children can wear jogging bottoms on these days.



Due to health and safety, children are unable to participate in PE lessons if they are wearing earrings or any other type of jewellery including watches and rings.

Friday Snacks

As agreed with our Parent Council, Friday will continue as a day where children can bring a treat to school. We would request parent support to ensure these treats are appropriate. I would ask that children avoid energy drinks, large family size bars of chocolate and crisps.

On Monday – Thursday, children should continue to bring healthy snacks and water to school.
