Exciting Changes

Since some of our children moved up to Primary 1, we have all moved in to new groups. You will be able to see what colour your child's group is on their learning journal. We are brushing our teeth with our new group every day in nursery.

We have also re-introduced self-serve snack to help build children's independence and self-help skills. It still runs as café snack each morning and afternoon so children can join whenever they feel hungry. Children will also be helping prepare the snack.

Every child now has their own drawstring bag which they will leave in nursery at all times. This will save you bringing a bag backwards and forwards. If you haven't already, please could you supply two full changes of clothes, indoor shoes (preferably plimsolls as opposed to slippers), wellies and waterproofs. Please can you name all items of clothing. If required, please also supply nappies/pull-ups and wipes. We will let you know if any supplies are running low so you can replenish.


