

#### Cold weather

# What have we been learning?

# The Daisy Room

In the Daisy Room, we have been exploring the season of Autumn. We have developed our knowledge of our local community as we have been going for walks around Twechar to spot any changes caused by Autumn.





We have developed our early numeracy skills whilst exploring a variety of pumpkins of different shapes, sizes and colours.

We have developed our curiosity as we have explored a variety of natural Autumn resources.

We have been developing our early literacy skills as we have been exploring the Dear Zoo story using a variety of props and role play resources.



Some of our Daisy room children are making the exciting move through to The Sunbeam Room alongside Arran. We can't wait to see the children develop, grow and thrive on their new adventure!

# What have we been learning?

#### The Sunbeam Room

We have had a busy couple of months with lots of fantastic learning going on. Fraser Bear has been helping the children to learn about the Vision, Values and Aims of the Nursery. In particular he has been helping the children to understand about the importance of being kind, looking after property and keeping safe. The children have responded very well to Fraser Bear and he is now firmly part of the Nursery. We have also been using the story of The Colour Monster to help understand feelings such as happy, sad, angry, scared and calm. At Welcome Time the



children have been posting a lollipop stick to show how they are feeling and are able to explain why they are feeling a particular way.

The children have been introduced to Talk4Writing and have engaged really well with this. Talk4Writing is a



programme which provides children with the skills to become confident story tellers and story writers by using well known stories as a framework. Our first focus story was "We're Going on a Bear Hunt" which proved to be very popular, with lots of different activities on offer e.g. puppets, small world figures and craft relating to the book. The children particularly enjoyed learning actions to the story and using a story map to help them retell the story. The children are currently voting for the next Talk4Writing story and it's between The Three

Little Pigs, Goldilocks and the Three Bears or Little Red Riding Hood so watch this space .......

The children have also been taking part in Word Aware sessions with Concept Cat. Word Aware is a programme which is used to expand and enhance children's vocabulary through direct teaching of words. The words were selected from the Talk4Writing story "We're Going on a Bear Hunt", namely wavy, long, shiny and narrow. The children took part in lots of different activities to reinforce their understanding of the words and they were encouraged to use the words in the correct context during their play.



It was Maths Week Scotland from 25/9/23 to 1/10/23 and the theme this year was Maths in Motion. We watched a story called JoJo Gnome and the Shape Map which was all about a Gnome who went on a shape



hunt and created a map to show all the shapes she had found. This inspired us to go on our very own shape hunt in the Quad where the children used the iPads to take photos of the shapes they found - we were surprised to find so many shapes all around us! We then used the photos to help us draw our shape maps, making sure that we drew the shapes in the correct order. Afterwards we put all our work together to create a big book of Shape Maps.
