

For your information, we do not have a breakfast club at Nursery. Children should have their breakfast before attending.


#### TIME-KEEPING


Please be aware of your child's session times as this can have an impact on the running of the Nursery day.

#### OUR LEARNING

In the STEM area, we have been exploring chemical reactions and observing the effect that different materials may have on each other. We have also been learning about Chinese New Year and we worked hard making a Chinese Dragon which we showcased as we paraded around the school. We have been developing our knowledge of our rights as children as we have been joining Arran every Wednesday morning for a small group time to learn all about Children's rights. In the Home Corner, we have been developing our independence as we have been learning about the skills required to look after a baby, we have also been developing our independence through a variety of cooking experiences including making our own soups. In the Creative area, we have been exploring Julia Donaldson's book 'Jonty Gentoo' and have been making different creations relating to the book. 
#### OUTDOOR LEARNING






#### SUMMER TRIP

LITERACY AND NUMERACY FOCUS

#### Literacy

This month the children have been learning the story of The 3 Little Pigs as part of our Talk4Writing programme. They learned to retell the story using actions and also had the opportunity to retell the story using a story map and story tray. We have also been focusing on the structure of stories particularly how we begin and finish stories e.g. "Once upon a time..... and they lived happily ever after. The end."




Through our Word Aware programme, Concept Cat has been teaching the children about different words selected from The Three Little Pigs story e.g. creeping, twisty, furious. These words are displayed each week on the Curriculum Board in the cloakroom so please take a look and ask your child about what the word of the week means.

The children used their drawing skills, which have been developed through Foundations of Writing, to draw detailed pictures of their favourite character and setting from the story of The 3 Little Pigs. "I'll huff and I'll puff and I'll blow your house down!"

#### Numeracy & Maths



The children have been developing their Early Number Sense by working on recognising and ordering numerals. We have also been using lots of mathematical language such as what number comes before, after, inbetween. This not only helps them to improve their counting skills but also helps develop problem-solving skills, and concepts such as sequence and patterns.



We have been also learning about weight, what we need to measure it and the language around weight such as heavy, heavier, light, lighter. The children have been exploring weight using lots of different types of scales, and using their problem solving skills to make both sides of a 2 pan scale balance.
